The Simplified, Accountable Board System | Part 6

A word about the Simple Accountable Board, the form of governance BUMC is moving toward. Based on my readings, here is a definition of "governance": It is the board's legal authority to exercise power and authority in the church on behalf of the membership. The board sets policies and makes decisions that affect the life and mission of the church. Governance is group action. Individual board members do not govern the organization. Rather, meeting as a group confers governing status to the board as a whole.


