Joy Is Foundational To Faith

Joy is foundational to faith. In the Old Testament there are 13 Hebrew root words expressing some aspect of joy. Most of them refer to joy or joyful participation in group worship.

Old Testament rejoicing in worship is connected with the following words:

- Singing
- Singing praise
- A loud voice/shouting
- Noise/uproar
- Dancing/leaping/stamping the feet
- Clapping
- Musical instruments:
 - Pipe
 - Harp
 - Trumpet
 - Flute
 - Stringed instruments

Joy in the Old Testament makes clear that our cause for rejoicing is ultimately in God and not ourselves. Joy is related primarily to God's triumph over evil, shown in recovery from illness, or some other victory of personal existence or of the nation.

In the New Testament joy is connected with God's salvation, or the joy of eating and drinking, or celebrating a festival. The one real difference between the Testaments' attitudes regarding joy is that the NT writers make the bold statement of joy in suffering as well as in salvation (Matthew 5:12). Joy can be found in weakness in terms of the power of God "made perfect in weakness" (II Corinthians 12:9).

In the late 1700's a derogatory British term applied to Methodists was "leaping Methodies." Evidently, the Methodist worship was highly charged with joy in the Old Testament tradition!

I invite you Sunday to gather for joyful worship, and I hope you will experience a little joy in your life this week!
