Churchwide Bingo Night • Sunday, August 14th 5-7.




SAVE THE DATE • SEP 30-OCT 2-STIRRED UP!

WE HAVE CONTINUED TO BE FORTUNATE. WE ARE CALLED TO REMAIN RESPONSIBLE.

It was the evening of the Festival de Noel five or six years ago as everyone was preparing for the program to begin. We had been having some problems with the lights working the way they should that afternoon and had called in the electrician. He got things back in order for the program but made no promises as the dimmer control panel installed in the steeple tower was outdated and rheostats and other parts were no longer available. The electrician, the Director of Music, Adam Philley, and I were standing in the balcony praying over the control panel.

We have been fortunate that a major failure has not occurred leaving us in the dark during a worship service or other gathering in the Sanctuary. The cost of replacing the control system and certain spotlights is \$ 177,659.

A significant grant of \$ 150,000 was offered by a generous donor family to replace the dimmer control panel. The Governance Board gratefully received the grant and with the addition of other gifts, the project has a remaining balance of \$18,459.

I would encourage you to assist with this most necessary task and give generously to complete the funding of this critical electrical system.
