



Pastor's Message Rev. Kelly Berne, Executive Pastor

It was super to see everyone for our church fun night on Sunday, Aug. 14th . About 150 of us gathered in Anderson Hall for a shared meal and to play bingo. Our church recently experienced one of the largest Sundays of this year, next to Easter Sunday, with 331 people worshiping together in person and 20 people joining us online for our Back-to-School Sunday. It gave me pause to think about the ways we are living out our mission, *inspiring people to Know, Grow, and Go in God's Love*, here at BUMC.

KNOW is about connecting people to church and God. It also about our commitment to attending worship, reaching people through online worship, and inviting others to come to worship and church events with us. We may ask ourselves, "How involved am I in knowing God's Word and love? And how involved am I with helping others know about my church and God's Word and love for them?" Part of our call to discipleship is a call to constantly and intentionally invite people to come and join us in knowing God's love for the world.

GROW is about developing as a disciple and leader. Are you plugged into a Sunday school class or small group? Have you discovered ways to grow as a leader here at BUMC? Dr. James Moore writes, "How are you stretching and enlarging your minds?" While it's important to belong somewhere that touches and inspires our hearts, it is just as important to stretch and grow our minds. Part of our call to discipleship is a call to learn and grow as a disciple.

GO is about engaging and serving the community. As disciples we are called to gather for worship, to grow and stretch our minds, and to scatter and serve God's kingdom. We paint houses, feed the hungry, clothe the naked, and remind the lost and forgotten that God is actively seeking them. Where there is darkness, we bring light. This is how we let our light shine for the world to see.

If I were to ask you how involved you were in any three of these aspects, how would you respond? Rev. Megan has launched a Discipleship Team to explore ways of outreach and how BUMC can be more visible in our community. Rev. Kelly is recruiting new members for the Missions Team. If you aren't sure, I encourage you to reach out to one of your pastors. We would love to help you get connected and inspire you to Know, Grow, and Go in God's love.




Encountering God
