The Governance Board meeting was held on July 17, at 4 pm in Pearce Hall and it was Rev. Dr. Price's first Board meeting. The following business was conducted:

Rev. Kelly Berne sent a communication to many of our members assessing their interest in participating and volunteering with St. Luke's Pumpkin Patch. Updated information:

Feedback was positive and she has moved forward with the partnership. Look for volunteer sign up opportunities starting in September. Pumpkin unloading will be September 25. We will meet at St. Luke's after the 11 a.m. worship for a shared meal, then unload pumpkins. BUMC will share in the proceeds made from the sale of pumpkins, which will go to fund future mission projects.

Under consideration is the revival of the Sunday morning breakfast snacks and the coffee crew. Feedback is being sought, especially from the Sunday School classes who provided the snacks. Some of the other changes to the church services that were made in response to Covid are also being reassessed.

The Louisiana Methodist Conference decided to refund some of the apportionment funds. Kenny Beauvais is the chairperson of the Conference on Finance and Administration and worked on these apportionment refunds. Our church was allocated \$7000 in refunds. Rev. Terry Love suggested that this money be used to pay an outstanding bill for the Sanctuary organ repairs in the amount of \$4288.00, and that the remainder be used to pay for our contract singers. The Board approved these requests. The choir has now reached its goal of being able to pay for new choir robes. The money came from non-budgeted donations. The Board approved this expense. The choir hopes to have enough donations soon to fund the purchase of stoles that top the choir robes.

You may notice that the portraits of the former senior ministers, that hang in the entrance hall to the office, are being moved. The sunlight that penetrates that area has been fading the portraits. The portraits will find a new home in the darker hall between the parlor and the chapel. The church received a generous \$150,000.00 donation for the repair of the Sanctuary lights, but there is still \$18,759.00 outstanding, which hopefully will be funded out of donations for that purpose.

New directors have been hired for the Broadmoor Buddies and the Early Learning Center (ELC) with Shelby Lockwood heading the Broadmoor Buddies and Lillie Daniel directing the ELC. We are looking forward to their leadership in these areas.

For all events, the church is requesting that Event Evaluations be filled out and returned to the office. This assessment helps the church gauge whether the event helped promote its vision of "knowing, growing, and going" and also provides information of what worked and what needs to be changed for future events. The Board this year has headed the Employee Appreciation Lunch, Happy Trails Pot Luck, Meet and Greet (for the Board), and the Breakfast with Wybra. Event Evaluation forms have been or will be filled out soon for these events. The next meeting will be held August 21, at 4 PM in Pearce Hall. All are welcome to attend.

GRAND GATHERING




SAVE THE DATE • SEPT. 30 - OCT. 2 • STIRRED UP RETREAT

With all the disruptions and erratic schedules that get in the way of our best intentions, an option of a recurring gift to the church is a great idea. Various options for recurring gifts to BUMC exist for your convenience. Choose the option that is best for you.

- 1. Direct Deposit, also known as Automated Clearing House payment (ACH) has been found to be most convenient and reliable for many of our participants. You complete an authorization form at the church, and we process your gift with your bank. You specify how much is drafted each month and to which fund/s you wish to give. You can adjust the arrangement at any time and there is no service fee from your bank. Also, most banks have a direct payment plan through checking and savings accounts.
- 2. You can also setup a recurring arrangement on your credit or debit card by going online to BroadmoorUMC.org and processing your gift under BUMC WEBSITE. Select "YES" when asked if you want this to be a recurring gift. Recurring giving is faithful assurance that you're investing year-round in life changing ministry that happens all year long even when you are not able to be present.


