The Simplified, Accountable Board System | Part 5

We are changing the governance of our church from standing Church Council, Trustees, Finance, and Staff-Parish Relations (human resources) committees/boards to a Simplified Accountable Board.

Accountable leadership depends upon clarity of roles. Churches with no clarity around authority often argue about who "gets" to make a decision that the decision is often made too late or is undermined at the first opportunity. Unfortunately, we've experienced that at BUMC in the past. The reason is that the complexity of authority sometimes creates blurry lines of authority that undermine accountability. It's time to do it differently. And more efficiently. And simply.

Here is where we're moving:

- **Simplified Board** = Role is governance (fiduciary & strategic work)
- **Pastors** = Role is leading the people into the mission field (the world beyond the walls) through communicating God's mission and vision
- **Staff** (paid & unpaid) = Role is managing the day-today ministry
- **Members** = Role is ministering to the church, the neighborhood, and the larger world

The **Board** is accountable to Christ for BUMC living its mission to make disciples. The **Pastors** are accountable to the board for the church's annual goals. The **Staff** (paid & unpaid) are accountable to the pastors for day-to-day ministry. The pastors are to make sure the ministries are aligned with the church's annual goals. Evaluating how things are going at each level is crucial.

This isn't an untested model. I've been reading *The Handbook* of Nonprofit Governance by BoardSource - this form of governance has much in common with other nonprofit organizations.

Are you a sheep or a goat?

come one of our Shut-In Ministry Saints (SIMS). Our **SIMS** Volunteers visit with an appointed shut-in help us stay connected



with our shut-ins, provide some love and relief of loneliness, and help to keep the staff and Pastors aware of any joys and concerns.
