The Simplified, Accountable Board System | Part 4

This is the fourth in a series concerning BUMC's streamlining of governance in 2020. It involves the reduction of boards and committees – fewer elected positions. Let's face it, volunteering is waning. People want to make their church participation count. They'd prefer doing something to know, grow and go in the faith – to strengthen their own discipleship and help make disciples for Jesus Christ rather than sitting on committees.

What we are talking about is not "getting rid of all our committees." All the committees still exist, but they are combined. Their responsibilities constitute the authority of the Simplified Accountable Board. In a nutshell: this Board IS the Finance Committee and IS the Staff-Parish Relations Committee and IS the Trustees and IS the Church Council.

Nothing in the Methodist "rule book", *The Book of Discipline*, is ignored or removed. The district superintendent has granted permission for this streamlining in governance. The roles and responsibilities of each of the constituent committees are each placed upon the new Board. This single committee then serves all the functions listed in the *Book of Discipline* for the Committees on Finance, Staff Parish Relations, Trustees, and Church Council.

Membership will consist of three classes (Class of 2020, 2021, & 2022). So about one-third of the board will rotate off annually. In addition, the Lay Leader, and Lay Delegate to Annual Conference will serve in the new structure. Potential members will be contacted by Nominating Committee members. We are looking for faithful, committed persons who will share their gifts with BUMC.

With permission, we will open up to the entire church body the approval of those agreeing to serve. In other words, for the sake of accountability, transparency and trust, we will give every member of the church the opportunity to vote on the Board members.

All meetings will be open and anyone can attend the meetings. It is likely the meetings will run 90 to 120 minutes. Initially, the Board will meet monthly.

I encourage you to attend and see what they're doing. For my part, this Fall I am going to attend a Simplified Accountable Board meeting at Henning Memorial UMC in Sulphur, to see it in action.


