December Mission Focus: The Gingerbread House This month we are collecting 1-ounce Play Doh, 8-ounce bottle water, and washable markers. All of these items are used daily in sessions with the children they serve. The Gingerbread House Children's Advocacy Center is a communitybased, non-profit that began serving abused children in 1998. The Center works in closely with local law enforcement, child protective services, the district attorney's offices, and medical and mental health professionals to provide the best possible services for abused children and their families. Gingerbread House coordinates interviews and investigations with the referring agencies and other professionals from the initial screening to the final disposition of the case. Through the Center's advocacy program, child victims and their families are prepared for the criminal justice process to help prevent further victimization. All services are provided at no cost to the victim's family or referring agency.
