Skinny Kids and Generosity

My dad is a new and used car salesman. He has done car sales my entire life. One of the sayings we had in the car business is that car salesmen have skinny kids. And that's because car salesmen work on commission. If he wasn't selling, we weren't paying bills. And unfortunately, being a salesman is often not about the skill of the salesman but about the market. He could truly sell wood to a forest, but if the economy isn't great, neither was the car business. So when it came time for generosity month at my home church, we wouldn't go to church as much. I think it was because we couldn't pledge our giving amount for the whole year since my dad's income truly varied depending on the type of economic year we were having. We felt like that month wasn't for us because the pastor really wanted pledges. So I grew to really dislike generosity month.

I truly understand why we don't like talking about money in the church, but it's critically important. Now that I sit in the associate pastor's office, and I'm not a kid in the pews, I see that the church needs a budget. We need to know which ministries we can provide for and which we can't. We need to know how we will actually "Know, Grow, and Go in God's love" this next year, and your pledge to the church helps us figure that out. I encourage you to take your generosity packet, pray about what God wants you to give this year, and bring it back on All Saint's Sunday (November 5) to be consecrated as we ask God to continue the story the Broadmoor UMC has partnered with God to make disciples of Jesus Christ. And if you are like my childhood family and just can't bring yourself to bring that packet in, I understand. Make a goal for yourself that is just a little higher than your giving from last year. Giving is a spiritual practice of placing trust in God.

A lot has happened in the past year, but I believe BUMC still is worth the investment. We can still be the light of Christ in our community.


Monster Mash




