Pastor's Message Dr. Greg Davis, Senior Pastor

We're in the middle of a sermon series, SHINE ON. It's about the light God gives us – Jesus, wisdom, insight, guidance. - Participate in worship on October 18th and consider the enduring light Christ brings to the ends of the earth as found in Acts 13:47.
- During the next week complete your financial and service commitments, and bring them to church with you on October 25, or mail them to the church.

So please join us on October 25th from 5:00-6:30 PM in Anderson Hall for dinner, social-distanced fun, and a chance to win some fun prizes.




BIBLE TIME!


It's Bible time for our PreK 4 and 3rd Grade friends!
