



### **Governance Board Message**

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Governance Board was held on Sunday, October 15, 2023.

Amy Watts, Business Administrator, reported the following:

- Our overall Revenue is lower than expected, including a year over year drop for September of \$29,000 from the same month last year.
- At the same time, expenses for September were also down from August, and were \$18,000 lower than the same month last year.
- Utility cost have been reduced (from the window tinting project), and personnel expenses are also lower.
- The carpeting has been replaced in three Day School rooms and the hallway and administrative entrance.

Traditionally, December is a month when non-pledge gifts accelerate.

Both the Buddies Program and the Day School are meeting financial goals. The ELC Program has some vacancies in the older age groups, while a waiting list still exists for younger children entering the program, that waiting list is almost full.

To date, we have twenty-eight new members for the year.
