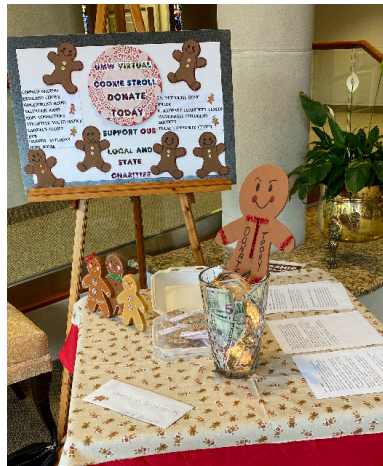

- ♦ Layette Ministry

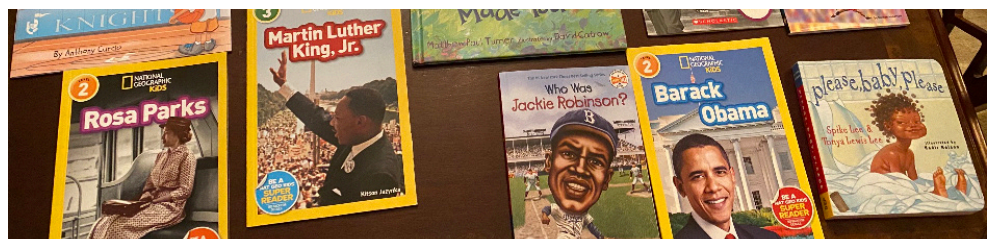

The Kids Hope programs have touched so many lives with their mission of hope for students and encouragement for the teachers and staff. I wanted to share a story from one of our mentors this fall.

Frank Flowers who has been a dedicated mentor for 12 years and has mentored 6 students was able to connect with one of his former students last November. Here is Frank's story.

"Last time I saw this guy was the End of the Year Party in 2009. I mentored him for 3 years at Arthur Circle. Long story, but I was looking for fishing supplies for an upcoming trip and called Bass Pro. I spoke to a young man about a fishing line. I asked his name – Jacoby... what's your last name – Fuller. Pause... did you go to Arthur Circle – Yes. I told him who I was – he fell out. I went to find him yesterday. He is doing well. He is a lot bigger (20 years old now!) I took along the picture of the two of us when he was 8, meeting Santa at the party. "

This story and others over the years continually remind me that our mentoring time and outreach creates success stories. In times like today, with so much isolation and upheaval, it is refreshing to hear this heartwarming story.
