"Giving up something" or "Giving of yourself" for Lent

Lent is a time of self-reflection. It calls us to imitate Jesus' fasting and trials in the wilderness and consider how we are to give of ourselves in the world.

This Lent, in place of being asked to "give up something" you are asked to "give of yourself" in a spiritual exercise of generosity.

In worship on Sunday, March 1st, a Lenten Challenge of daily prayer and scripture reading will be introduced to you. This exercise is to nurture your awareness of the spiritual aspects of generosity. As a real-time aspect of the exercise you are asked to consider increasing your giving by 1% of your income for six weeks and placing it in the offering each week as an act of worship.

Begin praying now that this Lenten Challenge will be a special experience for you and the congregation.


But here's the bottom line - If we're all works in progress, then we all must be moving towards something. But what are we moving towards? And are we sure we're moving the direction we want to go?
