#### **No Resurrection Without Death**

One of the many things I love about being a mainline Protestant, United Methodist in particular, is that we recognize that there cannot be resurrection without death. We live that reality out by attending both Good Friday and Easter Sunday services. While it may be fun to talk about the Easter bunny and get all dressed up in our Sunday best to attend Easter morning services, Easter Sunday rings a little dull when we forget to observe the season of Lent where we really examine ourselves and look in the mirror to dredge up all of those hidden sins and dead parts of ourselves. Without recognition of our sins, can we really celebrate Christ's triumphant resurrection for what it really is? It is victory over sin.

This Lent, we all do the hard work of asking ourselves, "What in our lives needs to die so that we may be resurrected as new people?" To answer that question we are venturing through the wilderness with Jesus in our sermon series "Into the Wilderness." We are giving up our frivolous indulgences so that we may extend our spiritual walk with God by spending more time with God and spending more time serving God's people. We are asking God to help us repent of our sins and die to our temptations so that we may be resurrected with Christ on Easter Sunday. I pray you find the time to give up what no longer serves you as you mourn on Good Friday, and I pray you take on what Easter Sunday's resurrection inspires in you as a new and whole creation. Fully live into what this season has to offer. Die to self, and rise in Christ.
