Governance Board Message

Our last meeting was Sunday, February 18th. Our January minutes were approved. Next, Amy Watts went over our finances reporting that revenues for January 2024 are down from January 2023 and December 2023. Expenses for January 2024 were higher than December 2023. Overall, we finished the month with a \$3000 net income due to our staff's diligence in keeping down expenses and using funds out of their restricted accounts as much as possible.

As of this meeting, 140 pledges for 2024 had been received. Yet, approximately 20 families from 2023 had not turned in a pledge. This has caused a shortfall of funds. Thus, a second appeal letter was sent out to the congregation asking those that hadn't pledge to do so, with a request to those who had turned in their pledge card to increase their original pledge if possible. Our budget must be completed before the end of March. Our hope is to receive additional pledges, so we do not need to cut staff or programs. We will discuss our financial status at the March meeting, after the congregation has had a chance to to act on their faithfullness to our church.

Both Ash Wednesday services were well attended. So was our Bingo event. All prizes for Bingo were donated by Sunday School classes and individuals.

All Holy Week church services are listed in the Messenger and included in the Order of Worship. Please make your plans to attend these services.

Our next meeting is March 17. Our meeting was adjourned.


