LIVING AND GIVING IN 1 A.D. (AFTER DEBT)

Back in the appearances and articles that I shared with you for six years about paying off the indebtedness of the church, an underlying motivation I often highlighted was that if we were not paying off debt those generous donations might be available for other purposes to grow the church. Of course, it was an overwhelming response of the congregation to give as generously as you did to become debt free. Now we are living in what I am calling 1 A.D., the first year after paying off the debt.

Each of you who made a donation to the BOLD Campaign to eliminate the debt, now has a new opportunity to assist the church to Inspire People to Know, Grow and Go in God's Love with the funds you were previously paying on the debt. Numerous members have already assigned their previous BOLD donations to other needs of the congregation. Monthly direct deposits and checks have been continued to address the need for special musicians with the choir, children and youth programming, supporting the BUMC endowment funds at the United Methodist Foundation to continue the ministry of the church far into the future. Recent special offerings have made available thousands of dollars to assist Ukraine refugees. And, with our grand worship complex there are always a list of needs to be addressed. At the present a new dimmer control system is being planned in the coming months for the Sanctuary to replace the obsolete system that is necessary for the lights to operate properly. \$150,000 has been pledged to the project with an additional \$28,000 to be raised.

It is a new day, a new era even, in the life of BUMC. There are many challenges and many opportunities too that we face in the living of each day. It is a new time for us to reexamine our gratitude for our blessed Savior and reorient the generosity in our hearts. Welcome to $LIVING\ AND\ GIVING\ IN\ 1\ A.D.$

NEW MISSION COMING UP





Nanih Chito United Methodist Church Wright City, Oklahoma

Date: June 4th, 2022 , June 11, 2022 (rain date)

Needs: carpentry, plumber, electrician, painters, (a few for cooling station).

This will be a day trip. It is 2 hours 40 minutes to the destination. We will leave at 6:00 a.m. There will be several phases to this project. Installing 2 doors, building wheelchair ramps, installing an electric water heater in the kitchen, and assessing pipes that were damaged in the freeze are part of the first phase.

The roof needs to be evaluated as to repairs or replacement needs. After the roof evaluation and repairs, painting the church needs to be done in another trip. There is also a sign that needs TLC. We are doing this with First Bossier UMC. We are looking for a relationship with this Native American Methodist Church. It is an older church, in a beautiful setting, that needs some tender, loving care! Everyone must be Safe Sanctuary trained* and have *Covid* vaccinations and insurance. This all part of the Oklahoma Indian Missionary Conference guidelines.
