A note from the Governance Board

A Food Service task force, chaired by Nancy Beauvais, is being formed to determine any needed kitchen improvements and food service needs at Broadmoor.

Broadmoor Buddies Director, Stephanie Smith, is stepping down to spend more time with her family. She will continue working through the month of July. Recruitment has begun for her replacement.

A new Sunday School class has been formed. Anyone interested in joining a new community of believers who want to learn more about faith and how to navigate life together, is welcome to attend.

LIVING AND GIVING IN 1 A.D. (AFTER DEBT)

It is a new beginning after having focused on paying off the indebtedness of the church for so long. Thanks again for all your generous donations to achieve this holy task.

In my last article I mentioned additional special needs that I would ask you to consider as we move into this new era of 1 A.D., the first year after debt. One project we have been nursing along for a number of years waiting for the right time to address is the dimmer control system of the lighting in the Sanctuary. The present system is approximately 70 years old and controls one-hundred light fixtures. It is outdated and obsolete from the standpoint of replacement parts not being available. We have been fortunate to this point that we have not had a major failure. Breakdown of this control system would cause major disruption of worship or any other activities in the Sanctuary.

The price tag on the demolition and replacement of this essential apparatus is \$ 177,659. Fortunately, a grant in the amount of \$150,000 has been pledged toward the project, for which we are very grateful. The remaining \$ 27,659 is to be raised so the project may proceed in July.

Your special donations to this new control system for the Sanctuary will be very much appreciated as we continue to be good stewards of the grand place we have been given in which to worship.
