## BUMC Governance Board

The BUMC Governance Board met for a regular monthly meeting on May 15. The meeting covered board areas of responsibility including Finance, Trustees, Staff-Parish Relations (SPR), and church council. We also reviewed recently completed and upcoming church events.

One significant upcoming event includes a farewell potluck lunch to honor Dr. Greg Davis as he retires after 8 years at Broadmoor and a total of 35 years in ministry. The lunch is scheduled for June 12 after the 11:00 worship services. Dr. Davis' last Sunday sermon at Broadmoor will be on Father's Day, June 19.

Dr. Wybra Price's first Sunday will be July 3. Dr. Price will be the 16th Senior Minister to serve at Broadmoor since the church was chartered in 1939.

A charge conference was held on May 22 to vote on continuance of the BUMC Governance Board. The alternative to the single Governance Board model is to have four separate committees (Finance, Trustees, SPR, and Church Council) that meet and operate separately. The result of the charge conference vote was to continue with the current Governance Board model where all members of the board share in the four areas of responsibility to fulfill requirements of The Book of Discipline.

### LIVING AND GIVING IN 1 A.D. (AFTER DEBT)

Now that Broadmoor UMC is debt free, there are other concerns to be addressed with the faithful, enthusiastic generosity you displayed to eliminate the debt. Currently, installation of a new dimmer control system is scheduled to begin in early July, for the Sanctuary. The age of the dimmer control system has been of significant concern for quite some time. It is obsolete from the standpoint of not having replacement parts available. What would be a normal repair to replace essential parts becomes a major problem when those parts are not available. We have been fortunate not to have had a substantial failure that would cause major disruption of worship, or any activities in the Sanctuary.

The installation will include the upgrade and relocation of the dimmer cabinet, replacement of the control board in the balcony, and replacement of the most prominent theatrical light fixtures that illuminate the chancel area.

**A grant of \$150,000 has been pledged to the total project cost of \$177,659. Other gifts have reduced the remaining balance to \$23,159. Your generous gifts to complete this important project are very much needed at this time and would be greatly appreciated.**

It is a new time for us to acknowledge the many challenges and opportunities we face, and to reexamine the gratitude for our blessed Savior as we reorient the generosity in our hearts. Welcome to LIVING AND GIVING IN 1 A.D.
