We are slowly reopening. Church worship is small, as we expected. There are different people attending on different Sundays, so we are confident it will slowly grow. In terms of Stewardship, June has seen a much more supportive response from the congregation than May, which is encouraging as we enter the heart of the giving doldrums in July and August.

There will be a **State of the Church** presentation by the Governance Board on **Sunday, July 26**th **at 10am in the Sanctuar**y. Its purpose is for the Board to share where BUMC is and what's going on. We struggled to name a convenient time: this is between the services, so we opted for it. If the turnout is poor, we'll consider moving the time to either closer to 11 o'clock service, or afterwards. We intend to provide video, either live or recorded and posted. We'll figure out the details.

Also, there will be a called Church Conference on Sunday, Aug 9th at 12pm in the sanctuary. The purpose of the conference is to vote Yes or No on continuing the Governance Board form of church governance. At the initial meeting in January 2020, the Governance Board passed a resolution that an annual vote would be taken regarding the governance format. The resolution said the vote is to be taken annually in May, but COVID-19 derailed that this year.

A subject of discussion in the last Governance Board meeting had to do with finding ways people can share their talents, expertise, and gifts with BUMC. It may be that the service pledge cards will be designed in such a way that we ask you what talents/expertise/gifts you have that you might be able to help the church with at some point.

Exciting news: Stephanie Smith is going to be the new Director of the Broadmoor Buddies program. Stay tuned for an upcoming article about her. We are very lucky to have such an excellent successor to Anne Cathcart.

Dallas Weeks has agreed to become The River Worship Leader director, replacing Amber Dent, who took a fulltime job elsewhere.
