WHAT'S THE POINT?

Recently, our youth director Kyle Boston led a UMY night called "What's the Point?" He talked to over twenty students about the "why" behind God and the "why" behind church. I thought it was an incredible idea. We all need to know "why" before we buy into a concept.

The mission of the church is to make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world. Jesus states in Luke 4:18-19, as he reads the scroll of Isaiah, that he came "to proclaim good news to the poor," "to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor." The purpose of the Church is to reach all so that they may know Jesus Christ.

May we recommit ourselves to be a people chasing after our "why."




Save the Date for our Youth Stock Sale!


