



Governance Board Message

The Governance Board was held on Sunday August 21 at 4:00 PM in Pearce Hall. Several items of business were covered as follows:

- Dr. Wybra Price stated that the On-Boarding sessions held 7/30 with the Governance Board and 7/31 with Staff were extremely educational and beneficial. An important discovery was the concern between what constitutes the responsibilities of the Governance Board and those of the Staff. It was determined there was a need for a Board-Staff liaison. Amy Watts has graciously accepted this new position. Dr. Price also stated that the timeline for release of BUMC's updated strategic plan would be Spring 2023. He has quite a bit more learning and listening to the staff and congregation to do.
- Rev. Terry Love stated that BUMC is in good financial shape as off 7/31/22. Highlights of his report included the replacement of the Video Projector Bulb at a cost of \$1,505.88 and the decision to leave the Senior Minister portraits in their current positions and just tint the adjacent windows for a cost of \$350.00. This decision was based on the fact that moving the portraits would result in the need to repaint the walls while tinting the glass achieves the purpose of protecting the portraits from sunlight and leaving them in an accessible hallway for maximum viewing.
- Rev Kelly Berne reported that REALM software is being updated and soon will be launched (with training) for use by the entire congregation. The APP is available for download now.

Our Stirred Up Retreat is rapidly approaching and Kristin and I are so excited to be able to provide an opportunity for our church family to connect and reconnect with one another.



Book & Bible Studies




Encountering God
