"An Unlikely Advent, Extraordinary People of the Christmas Story" by Rachel Billups will be our four-week Advent 2023 study. Join Rev. Mimi McDowell and Dr. Wybra Price on four Mondays beginning November 27 at 10:00am or 6:00pm as we seek to find a place where we belong in the Advent story. This four-week Advent study focuses on the experiences of four sets of often overlooked characters in the Nativity story. Rachel Billups guides readers through the themes of hope, love, joy, and peace by sharing the stories of Elizabeth and Zechariah, Herod, the Magi, and the shepherds. Each set of unexpected characters has something to teach about living faithfully on the journey to Christmas.
