### March Mission Focus: St. Luke's Episcopal Medical Ministry 🔽

The St Luke's Medical Mission has been serving the needs of our community since 2008. St. Luke's uses a medical RV and provides free preventive health screenings, basic health services, health education, and medical referrals on a regular basis to the underserved in the rural and urban Louisiana communities of Caddo, Bossier, Webster, Desoto, and Claiborne parishes. As part of their medical mission they are in need of small sizes of certain over the counter medications that they can give to their clients that are in need. During March we would ask that you consider purchasing and donating the following items for their medical mission: *Anti itch creams - small tubes so we can give to the client .5oz size, Neosporin, Cortisone Cream, Calamine Lotion, Chap Stick, Sun Screen, Bug Spray, Alcohol, Voltaren type Cream, Prilosec or Omniprezole, Antidiarrhea meds, Cough drops, Disinfectant Wipes.* These items would go directly to those in need, and because they prefer smaller sizes are costly and difficult for them to keep in supply on their medical van.
