AUGUST MISSION FOCUS: UMCOR-SAGER BROWN DEPOT FLOOD BUCKET CLEANING KITS

The August Mission Focus is providing the supplies to fill flood buckets for the UMCOR Sager-Brown Depot in Baldwin, Louisiana. The United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) assists victims of natural and man-made disasters all over the world. UMCOR's Sager Brown warehouse collects cleaning, hygiene, and school kits for distribution in the United States. In preparation for the 2023 hurricane season, Sager Brown needs your help to assemble additional cleaning kits to replenish their supply. You can scan the QR code to find the complete list of items needed for a flood bucket. Items ordered from Amazon will be shipped directly to BUMC. You may donate individual items and bring them to the donation baskets by the sanctuary and church office, or you may wish to fill a flood bucket with the specific items required for a complete bucket. A list of items and packing directions is available at the donation baskets. UMCOR has specific guidelines for item size and packing the kits, so please read the instructions before purchasing items.
